*I know you watch somewhere up there probably laughing your ass off at the shit I be getting into. girl I need your ass here. I need my back up. I miss you.*

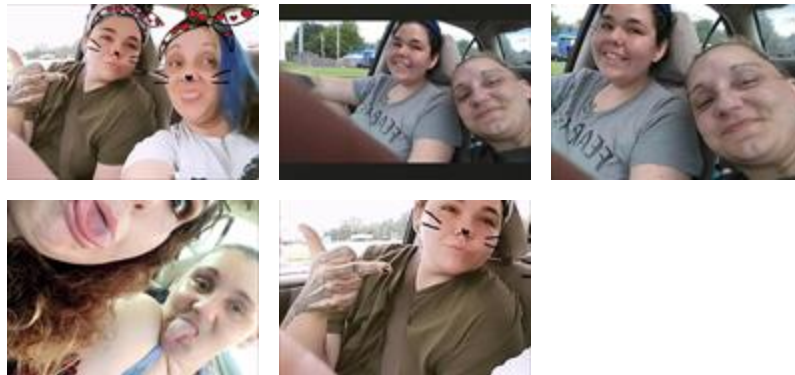

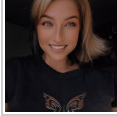
