



## Anna Isabel Clark

May 10, 1911 - March 27, 2012

Services were 2 p.m. Friday, March 30, at Montgomery-Viets Chapel with Pastor Tim Case officiating. Music selections were "Go Rest High on that Mountain," "Amazing Grace" and "Wings of a Dove." Burial was in Plad Cemetery under the direction of Montgomery-Viets Funeral Home of Buffalo. Visitation was 1 p.m. to service time at the funeral home.

Anna Isabel Clark, 100, Buffalo, was born May 10, 1911, in Des Moines, Iowa, the second child and first daughter of George William and Eva Linna (Riddle) Reed. She died March 27, 2012, at Colonial Springs Healthcare Center, Buffalo.

For personal reasons she chose to use the middle name Isabel and to celebrate her birthday on May 14. The Reed family moved to Springfield in 1913, and eventually moved to the Plad area in northeastern Dallas County. She was married to Samuel Harrison Clark on March 26, 1934, in Springfield. He was from rural northern Lincoln County, Nebraska, and this was where she lived and started her family.

They moved to Stapleton in Logan County, Nebraska, in 1942, and lived there until the fall of 1947. Her husband died in October 1947, and she moved with her children back to the Plad area. She lived the rest of her life in the Springfield and Dallas County areas.

She only attended rural elementary school through the seventh grade, and

spent her latter teen and early 20s assisting her mother in raising her younger brothers and sisters. She enjoyed writing poems, many of which were published in various local newspapers wherever she lived.

She had been a resident of the Colonial Springs Healthcare Center since the spring of 2006.

She was preceded in death by her parents; her husband, Samuel; an infant daughter, Lennie; brothers: George, Eldon, Ralph, Henry and Donald; and sisters: Esther and Rita.

Survivors include three sons: Melvin and wife, Caroline Clark, Pennsylvania, George and wife, Mary Clark, Stockton, and Harold and wife, Pat Clark, Tunas; eight grandchildren; 10 great-grandchildren; nine great-great-grandchildren; and a brother, Carl Reed; numerous step-grandchildren and their descendants; and many other relatives and
