Billie Joe Glass, 73, was born October 14, 1947, in Louisburg, the son of Joe L. and Ruby Alta (Wing) Glass. He died January 28, 2021, at Citizens Memorial Hospital, Bolivar.

Billie was reared in Louisburg and went to school in Buffalo where he graduated. He was in the United States Army and served in the Vietnam War from 1969-1971.
