Calvin LeRoy Hobbs, 83, son of the late Rev, Everett Eli Hobbs and Katie Etna (Hill) Hobbs Baggs, was born on March 15, 1938 in Lawson, MO and departed this life on April 24, 2021 at his home near Buffalo, MO.
