



Clell Norman Spoering

July 15, 1918 - December 28, 2013

CLELL N. SPOERING, 95, OF BUFFALO, DIED AT 3:55 P.M. SATURDAY DECEMBER 28TH AT COX-SOUTH HOSPITAL IN SPRINGFIELD. HE WAS A RETIRED FARMER AND MECHANIC, AND A NAVY VETERAN OF WWII. HE IS SURVIVED BY HIS WIFE, BERNICE; ONE SON, GARY SPOERING OF FIRESTONE, CO; THREE DAUGHTERS: JUDY SPOERING OF DENVER, CO, SHIRLEY NAEGELIN OF PAPIILLION, NE, AND DENISE MAXWELL OF DAVIDSON, N.C., ONE BROTHER: WESTON SPOERING OF BUFFALO; 9 GRANDCHILDREN AND 8 GREAT-GRANDCHILDREN.
