



Dillard Lendon Belt

March 7, 1926 - September 20, 2011

They moved to Wichita, Kan., to start a job at Boeing in 1950. He retired from Boeing after 31 years of service in 1983.

They moved back to Windyville where he spent about 10 years remodeling and building their retirement home. It started out as a two-bedroom home and was made into a four-bedroom home where many children and grandchildren spent fun times on the 80-acre farm. They sold the farm in 2000 and moved to Lebanon.

He was preceded in death by his parents; one son, Ollie Lendon Belt, in 2004; a daughter, Linda Cheryl Belt, in 1998; a grandson in 1980; and four brothers and sisters.

grandchildren; three great-great-grandchildren.
