



## Frances Hazelrigg

September 6, 1917 - October 2, 2009

Graveside services were at 11 a.m. Wednesday, Oct. 7, at Maple Lawn Cemetery with the Rev. Dr. Tom Geer officiating. Burial is under the direction of Montgomery-Viets Funeral Home of Buffalo.

Frances J. Hazelrigg was born Sept. 6, 1917, in Barry County, the youngest daughter of Harvey Joseph and Virginia Lee (Livingston) Hill. She died Oct. 2, 2009, at Ash Grove Healthcare Center where she had been living since February.

Her formative years were lived mostly in northwestern Missouri, where she graduated high school and then attended nursing school. She formerly lived in Dallas County and resided in Springfield before entering the assisted living facility.

She was united in marriage with Robert "Bob" Hazelrigg on June 1, 1938. They established a household first in Savannah, then in St. Joseph, as she continued her work in the nursing profession.

Soon after World War II, she and her husband, and their two young sons, moved to a farm south of Buffalo. There she was active in nurturing her family, in making a success of the farming venture and in being a good neighbor to all.

After her boys were reared, she and her husband moved to the Kansas City area.

She was preceded in death by her parents; and her husband, Bob, in 1996. Survivors include two sons: Larry, Tallahassee, Fla., and David and wife,

Connie, Ash Grove; two grandsons: Kevin and Christopher and granddaughter-in-law, Jennifer; one granddaughter, Katherine; five great grandchildren: Cortney, Madison, Tyler, Andrew and Alexis; and several nieces and nephews.
