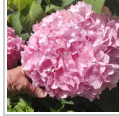

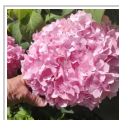

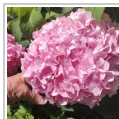

RIP George Semper Fi.

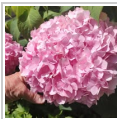
