Glenn H. Sipes was born May 22 1928 at Mound City, Missouri the son of Earl and Josephine (Elliott) Sipes. He died Thursday, July 4th 2013 at his home in Buffalo. Glenn served his country in the Air Force for 22 years. He was in the Air Launch Missile Program and Strategic Air Command.. He retired in 1968 with the rank of Chief Master Sergeant. Always a carpenter at heart, after retirement, he built campers, houseboats, and houses with his son Brian. in 1996 he started volunteering with Reading Buddies at Mallory Elementary He would also greet the kids when they got off the buses in the mornings. He did this until he could no longer walk the halls. He and his wife Sara Beth were married June 12th, 1976. They spent their life together at the home they built, until moving to town in 2011. He loved and enjoyed his family. He was a special "Pa" to his grandchildren and was also known as Pa at reading buddies. He is survived by his wife, Sara Beth; Children: Brian Sipes, Bruce and Janna Bradley and their son, Jared; Beth Howell and her daughter, Allyson, Becky Schofield and her son, Bradley; and Parris Blair; and was the oldest of seven children, six sisters , three of whom survive him: Edna, Nancy, and Jenny.
