



## Hearl Thomas Gann

December 4, 1926 - November 14, 2015

Mr. Hearl T. Gann was born December 4, 1926 in Springfield, Missouri, the son of Oscar and Maude (Cook) Gann. He departed this life November 14, 2015 at the Jordan Creek Nursing Facility in Springfield at the age of 88 years, 11 months and 10 days of age. He was a retired farmer and a longtime member of the Green Mountain Church. On March 31, 1945 he was united in marriage with Gloetta Gann and this union was blessed with three sons.
