November 26, 1928 - October 10, 2013

IDENA MAE "DEE" SPENCER WAS BORN IN COLE CAMP, MO, NOVEMBER 26, 1928, THE DAUGHTER OF HEINRICH DIEDRICH EBELING AND CLARA MATHILDA (LUETJEN). SHE DEPARTED THIS LIFE ON THURSDAY OCTOBER 10TH AT 8:10 A.M. IN THE CITIZEN'S MEMORIAL HEALTHCARE FACILITY, BOLIVAR, SHE WAS 84 YEARS, 10 MONTHS AND 14 DAYS OF AGE. SHE WAS MARRIED JUNE 10, 1944, TO JOHN WESLEY SPENCER AND THIS UNION WAS BLESSED WITH 5 CHILDREN. A HOMEMAKER, SHE ESPECIALLY ENJOYED MAKING QUILTS FOR THE ENTIRE FAMILY, FINISHING HER LAST QUILT BLOCK SEPTEMBER 28TH. SHE ALSO LOVED TO COOK FOR HER FAMILY, AND WAS ACTIVE IN HER HUSBAND'S MINISTRY OVER THE YEARS INCLUDING TEACHING SUNDAY SCHOOL. SURVIVORS INCLUDE HER HUSBAND OF 69 YEARS, JOHN, FIVE CHILDREN: SYLVANIA EVERSOLE OF BROWNINGTON, MO, GILBERT (SANDY) SPENCER OF SPRINGFIELD, MO, LAURA SUTHERLAND OF URBANA, HELEN McCOY AND DON BRUBECK OF BOLIVAR AND NANCY SPENCER OF URBANA, 10 GRANDCHILDREN: LETA (DEWAYNE) BEDFORD, LESA (TIM) DESKINS, VICKY (KEVIN) KAYS, JAMES (ELAINE) SPENCER, ANITA (JERROD) WATSON, GIDGET (RON) BURGETT, DAVID (BOBBIE) ROTRAMEL, STEPHANIE (DUSTIN) LONGORIA, TOMMY (KELLY) McCOY, AND STELIA (EJ) LOCKHART, 23 GREAT GRANDCHILDREN AND 5 GREAT GREAT GRANDCHILDREN.
