persistence, love, and care, she turned this dream into a reality, changing the lives of hundreds of people on her path through life.

Her pride and joy in this life was her boys, Sean, Tanner, and Kade. She was enormously proud of both their athletic and academic achievements, and never missed a game. She loved her boys and her husband, Gary, more than anything on this earth, and continually supported them in all ventures and walks of life. Jacqueline loved watching cooking shows, Little House on the Prairie, and Will and Grace. She loved Reba McIntire, Pat Benatar, and Beyoncé, and could keep a hand-tap beat while driving to any song, with a beautiful hum and voice to follow. Jacqueline loved antiques, the horse races at Oaklawn, trips to St. John, and spending time poolside at Nana and Papa's, as well as traveling to her son's sporting activities; no matter how far. If it was family related whatsoever, Jacqueline was there.

Jacqueline was preceded in death by her mother, Cecile, and one son, Dane. She is survived by her father, Gary Boggs; sister, Sandra Rutherford; husband, Gary Kelley; three sons, Sean, Tanner, and Kade and wife Annie.
