Jimmy is a 1964 graduate of Higbee High School, and received his bachelor's degree from Northeast Missouri State in Kirksville. Upon graduation, he joined the US Navy, serving as a gunner's mate aboard the USS Charles F. Adams from 1969 to 1973.

Jimmy went on to spend 40 years as a High School Math teacher between Higbee and Westran High Schools. where "Mr. Baker" was a fixture of the math department and a mentor to generations of students.
