



## James Michael Cline

October 30, 1952 - September 1, 2017

James Michael Cline age 64 of Conway Missouri, was born in Springfield, Missouri on October 30, 1952 . He was raised in the Charity area where he went to school for 8 years and then completed high school in Buffalo in 1970. James was preceded in death by his father, James Leon, in 1954, his mother, Velda Ardenell, in 1955, and his youngest son, Adam, on March 31, 2015. He is survived by his wife, Yvonne, of 43 years, his son Jason (Lia), and numerous cousins.

After the death of his parents, he was raised by his uncle and aunt, Larry John and Barbara Cline, on his parent's home place where he learned to fish and hunt and worked hard on the farm.

James served his country for 20 years spending time in Oklahoma, Alaska, Germany, and Missouri where he retired.

After retiring from the Army, James became an over-the-road truck driver and traveled all 48 states and several Canadian provinces as well. During this part of his life, his wife got her license and helped him drive.

Just as James was thinking about retiring from trucking, and staying home more and raising cattle, he found out his son had brain cancer. Eight months after his son lost his battle, James discovered he had cancer as well. After successful surgery and getting a clean bill of health, two years later, cancer struck for a second time.

James passed away at his beloved family home on September 1, 2017 surrounded by his loved ones.

Funeral Services will be at 11:00 a.m. Wednesday September 6, 2017 in the Elkland Independent Methodist Church with Rev. Nicholas Inman officiating. Music will be recorded selection. Pallbearers will be Jason Cline, James Cline, Terry Cline, Harold Gann, Dale Richerson, Cory Richerson, and Charlie Gann. Visitation will be Wednesday from 9 to 11 A.M. before Services.
