James Eugene Mullinix was born Feb. 16, 1920, at Shenandoah, Iowa, the son of James G. and Eunice (Wright) Mullinix. He died Feb. 12, 2011, at Lees Summit.

He graduated from Hamburg, Iowa, in May 1939, and then went to work at Longview Farms at Lees Summit.

He enlisted in the Army on Sept. 16, 1942. He was in the 959th Field Artillery Brigade and was wounded in the European Theater Aug. 23, 1944.

He was united in marriage with Gladys Karr on April 29, 1946, and to this union two daughters were born.

He served as Dallas County clerk from 1947 to 1958, and then moved to Greenwood and started to work for General Services Administration in 1961. He retired from G.S.A. in 1980.

He moved to John Knox Village in Lees Summit in 2002.

He was preceded in death by his parents; an infant brother, Bobby; a sister, Joy Howell; and two grandsons: Ronald Richard Allen Jr. and Gregory Brent Riffle.

Survivors include his wife of 64 years, Gladys; two daughters: Connie and husband, Ron Allen, and Sherry and husband, Mike Cowley; five grandchildren; nine great-grandchildren; and other family and friends will greatly miss him.
