Juanita Rae Gregory Glor, age 92, of Buffalo, was born August 10, 1924 to Janes Ornest Gregory and Annie Elizabeth Johnson Gregory in Lead Hill, Arkansas. Juanita was called home to meet her Savior on May 19, 2017. She married Elwood Franklin Glor on July 25, 1939. With her marriage to Elwood she lovingly added his two young sons, Jay and Gene, to her new family. Two more children, Lonnie and Rhonda, were born to Elwood and Juanita. They were married for 65 years before Elwood passed away in March of 2005. Juanita worked several years as a waitress and then as a clerk at Woods Super Market. Elwood and Juanita owned and operated the Nemo Heated Fishing Dock and later the Holiday Fishing Dock on Pomme de Terre Lake for several years. She returned to her work as a waitress at Gene's Restaurant until she retired. Juanita was an excellent bowler. She put her bowling ball down for the last time at the young age of 90. She loved her Lord and often spoke of the goodness and blessings God had given her during her life.
