



Kenneth Eldon Harrell

Kenneth E. Harrell was born September 8, 1929 at Bennett Spring, MO, the son of LeRoy and Violet (English) Harrell. He passed away May 2, 2016 at 2:40 P.M. in his home surrounded by family. He was united in marriage with Ethel Belle (Clemmons), and this union was blessed with 10 children. They were married for 65 years. He lived for a number of years in Kansas City, Kansas before retiring from Owens-Corning Fiberglass. After that, they moved to Lead Hill, AR where he drove a bus for the Lead Hill School District for several years, and then moved to Hermitage, MO. He and Ethel were Foster parents for 33 children for 10 years, and were named Arkansas Foster Parents of the Year. He was also a Union member.
