



## Lawrence Davis Skinner

November 24, 1929 - November 12, 2009

He enlisted in the U.S. Army in 1954, and was honorably discharged in 1959, due to a debilitating back injury. He held many odd jobs over the years as his health allowed. He was a longtime member of the D.A.V.

He was a very giving and thoughtful person who was always willing to help others. Some of his favorite pastimes included hunting, fishing, gardening and playing cards with family and friends.
