Mrs. Opal Mammy Hayes age 105 of Buffalo passed away Saturday November 30, 2019 in the Colonial Springs Health Care Facility Buffalo, Missouri. She was born June 27, 1914 to Wilburn and Flora Ann (Allman) Owens. She went to grade school at Engle School. She was united in marriage to George Hayes on May 10, 1932 and to this union they had 4 children. Opal was a member of the Freewill Baptist church.
