Ralph E. Cox, 82, of Buffalo, passed away Saturday, November 25th at Colonial Springs Healthcare Facility, following a long illness. He was born December 2, 1934 to Harry and Wilma (Sikes) Cox. At the time of his death he was 82 years, 11 months and 23 days of age.
