Roy Emerson Caswell, 76, passed away suddenly Saturday, December 3rd, 2016 at Cox South Hospital in Springfield, Missouri. Roy was born in Elwood, Indiana on February 18, 1940 to Lola Mae (Speer) and LG Caswell. He grew up in Lebanon, Missouri and attended Lebanon schools. He and his wife, Shirley, moved to Buffalo, Missouri in 1967 where they owned and operated the Buffalo Auto Salvage until they retired in 2010.
