



## Selma Bethel Owens

October 18, 1917 - April 21, 2010

Services were 2 p.m. Saturday, April 24, at Lindley Christian Church with the Rev. Rick Peterson officiating. Music was by Shirley Nasalroad, pianist. Burial was in Lindley Cemetery under the direction of Montgomery-Viets Funeral Home of Buffalo.

Escorts were James McCaslin, Russ Plaster, Cody Ranklin, Emmett Redd, Nathan Redd and Claire Reed. Honorary escort was Bobby Anderson.

Selma Bethel Owens was born Oct. 18, 1917, at Buffalo, the daughter of Charley and Goldie (Ricketts) Anderson. She died April 21, 2010, at Colonial Springs Healthcare Center, Buffalo, at the age of 92 years, 6 months and 3 days.

She lived with her family on a farm northwest of Buffalo. She and her siblings attended Crescent School and the Lindley Christian Church. When she was older, she began teaching Sunday school, which she did for over 50 years. She was united in marriage with Ernest Wilburn "Web" Owens, a man from a neighboring farm, on May 5, 1946. Shortly after they married, the couple received their own farm on 40 acres northwest of Buffalo, just off of Route C. They had no children, but her brother, Omer, lived with the couple for many years on the farm.

When her husband died in 1994, she and her brother continued to live on the farm although they no longer raised livestock. When her brother died in 2007, she continued to live on the farm until this year when her failing health finally caused her to move to the nursing home.

She was a staunch Republican and a rather solitary woman who loved to raise chickens and a vegetable garden. She also had beautiful roses and tulips around her house that she was very proud of.

Survivors include numerous nieces and nephews from around Buffalo, and Oklahoma and Wyoming.
