December 7, 1920 - January 4, 2010

Vera Arlene Winslow was born Dec. 7, 1920, in Union Center, Neb., the daughter of James A. and Myrtle Johnson. She died Jan. 4, 2010, at Webco Manor, Marshfield, at the age of 89 years and 28 days.

She was united in marriage with Glenn A. Winslow on Aug. 26, 1936, and to this union three daughters were born.

She came to Jesus early in life, and serving him was a very important aspect of her life. She came into the Church of Christ in Rose Hill, Kan., and after moving to Missouri attended church at both Buffalo and Bolivar Church of Christ.

She and her family lived in Beatrice, Neb., for a number of years where she was a housewife and mother. They then moved to a farm at Urbana, and later she lived near Louisburg, then in Buffalo. She spent the last two years of her life at Webco Manor in Marshfield.

She was preceded in death by her parents; three brothers; her husband; and an infant son, Terry Lynn.
