She was saved as a teenager and joined Green Mountain Missionary Baptist Church.

She worked as a pharmacist assistant for several years. Later they owned and operated a bicycle shop. She was a member of Twin Lakes Baptist Church in Aptos, Calif.

She was preceded in death by her parents; her husband, Edward; and six brothers: Orville, Virgil, Gordon, Hershel, John and Gail Pinkley.

Survivors include her brother, Joseph and wife, Helen Pinkley, Olathe, Kan.; three sisters: Vinnie Brown, Buffalo, Lorene Harper, Zaneville, Ohio, and Geneva and husband, George Medlin, of Olathe, Kan.; and several nieces and nephews.
